Waterfowl Packages

Within 20 minutes of Tumbleweed Lodge, the Missouri River holds one of the best migratory flights of Canada geese in the country. The prairie skies fill with Canada geese, speckle bellies, snows, blues and mallards; hunting over decoys or pass shooting the bluffs are the methods of our success. The license fee is \$85.00 (subject to change) and the goose option is \$395.00 per hunt. Thanks in part to an agreement between private land owners in Hughes county and the Dept. of Game, Fish, and Parks, non-residents are able to obtain a license over the counter instead of a random drawing system. We recommend booking between the 1st weekend in December and mid January for the Waterfowl option.
